Title: IHM – Local Florida Approved Service Supplier

For yachts entering European waters after the 31 December 2020, a new EU regulation the EU Ship Recycling Regulation (EU SRR) will be in force. This is similar to the Hong Kong Convention (HKC) which has yet to be ratified on a global basis. What this means to you is that an Inventory of Hazardous Materials (IHM) will need to be made and certified by Class for any vessel over 500GT regardless of Flag or Registration. The HKC is expected to be ratified this year or early next year and enforcement will begin at a later date as all new conventions do.

The IHM must be conducted by an independent Haz Mat expert, materials aboard logged and representative samples of materials sent to independent laboratories for Haz Mat analysis.

Fairport Yacht Support has worked diligently to secure an approved vendor in the area, previously there are some operating in Europe, Canada, and the Far East, but none in the USA equipped to work on yachts.

According to the Lloyd's Register website, the overview of the IHM is:

Inventory of Hazardous Materials (IHM) is a structured system to control hazardous materials onboard ships and achieve compliance with the EU Ship Recycling Regulation (EU SRR) and Hong Kong Convention (HKC) for the Safe and Environmentally Sound Recycling of Ships.

From December 31, 2020, any ship which is 500 GT or over, regardless of flag, will require a valid and certified IHM on board if calling at an EU port or anchorage. Non-EU flagged vessels can also be certified against EU SRR by complying with the HKC IHM requirements.

In order to comply, the steps will consist of:

- Identify a Haz mat expert
- Haz Mat expert gathers required drawings and documents from the yacht, conducts material sampling and an inventory aboard

- A report is generated which includes laboratory testing results of certain categorized items
- The report is sent to Class, where it will be approved
- Class attends the yacht to conduct verification of the inventory content and issues a Statement of Compliance
- The statement is valid for 5 years and during that period a responsible person aboard maintains the inventory list, recording any changes
